Cheakamus Centre NIT Grievance Resolution

We are very pleased to announce that we have been able to reach a resolution to our grievance on the failure of the District to provide NIT for teachers attending the Cheakamus Centre. The District has confirmed that teachers attending the Cheakamus Centre with their classes for a school program are entitled to their regularly scheduled NIT during their teaching time.

As part of the resolve, there are two ways this NIT can be delivered. The first option is for teachers to be relieved of their supervisory duties during the instructional day. This could be done by having an administrator visit the Cheakamus Centre and teach a portion of the teacher's field study. As many administrators often do not visit the Cheakamus Centre, a second option would be to continue the practice that has already been followed at many Elementary schools: The school keeps track of the missed NIT and this time is made up at a letter date. The scheduling of this time for the affected teacher is to be done in consultation with the school Principal.

What does this mean for teachers visiting the Cheakamus Centre with their classes?

You are entitled to any NIT that you miss when at the Cheakamus Centre. This NIT can be delivered by a visiting school principal or vice-principal. This NIT is to be delivered only during the teacher's supervisory commitments during the instructional day.

Alternately, this missed NIT can be made up upon the teacher's return to their school at a time that works for both the teacher and the principal. Next school year, please do not hesitate to contact the NVTA if this grievance resolve is not followed. We thank the District for reaching an agreement on this issue.
