NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING

Proposed motions for consideration at the General Meeting

- 1. That the NVTA fee for the 2019-2020 school year be set at 0.80% of a teacher's salary.
- 2. That the NVTA Executive Committee Days Policy for the 2019/2020 school year be adopted.
- 3. That compensation in the amount of \$332 be provided to each executive member (excluding the President, 1st Vice President, and 2nd Vice President) and standing committee chairperson who attends the Summer Planning Session.
- 4. That CSRs be provided with gift cards according to a formula as determined by the Representative Assembly and within a budget amount to be set by the General Meeting.
- 5. That the proposed budget 2019/2020 be adopted.
- 6. That the proposed NVTA Goals & Priorities for 2019-2020 be adopted (see page two)

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Welcome back to a new school year. I hope your summer was a real break where you could finally spend time with friends and family, go on that vacation you've promised yourself for a long time, or just relax and catch up on your reading list. Whatever you did this summer, I hope you had the time to rest and rejuvenate for another exciting year.

As we finish the first week of the year it's time to look ahead to the next ten months and determine the best way to provide another year of learning and discovery for your students. Teaching is unique in that every year you start fresh with new students and parents, with many new colleagues and with an opportunity to try out a new lesson or unit you've been working on.

As many of you are aware, Provincial Bargaining is still going on through a Labour Relations Board appointed mediator. After many days of mediation during the summer, the parties are taking a break from face-to-face talks to focus on refining the articles tabled in order to reach a deal. I strongly encourage all of you to visit the BCTF portal to find out more information about bargaining. There you will find bargaining updates as well as proposals from the BCTF and BCPSEA. It is important that you keep yourself informed of the progress of bargaining, as often what you hear in the media is not accurate. We have concluded local bargaining and have agreed to three article changes to the Collective Agreement. More information on this will come as we prepare for a ratification vote.

Schools should be receiving more detailed information on the results of the Employee Engagement Survey carried out by the district. The NVTA Executive will also be receiving some more detailed results soon and will engage with the district on what those results mean and how we can work together to improve some of the areas that scored lower on the survey. The NVTA Executive will be reaching out to members on this to ensure that your voice continues to be heard and listened to.
