BCTF CALL-OUT FOR BCTF AGM CHAIRPERSON

The Federation is seeking an additional chairperson for the upcoming Annual General Meeting (AGM) and would like to bring this opportunity to the attention of members who have some chairing experience and would be interested in taking on this role. The BCTF will provide training and time to meet experience AGM chairpersons.

As per procedure, The Executive Committee (EC) selects the AGM chairpersons and then the AGM deals with the recommendation to formally adopt the chairpersons at the very beginning of the meeting. As per Procedure 2.A.08, the EC will be considering the need for inclusion of members who identify as being from equity-seeking groups when they make the selection. It is also important to note the new criteria in Procedure 2.A.08 stipulates that the chairpersons:

- i. not be voting members of the AGM and not hold any other elected or appointed role at the meeting.
- ii. avoid engaging in debate from the floor on the business matters before the AGM.

Please consider this opportunity. There is a short application form on the BCTF website. As the intention is for the EC to make the selection at their January 30 meeting, the deadline for applications is 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 28, 2020.

LOCAL RATIFICATION VOTE RESULTS

The ratification vote for the local Agreement in Committee was held on January 22, 2020. NVTA members voted 98 percent in favour of accepting the agreement. The following changes (in italics) have now been ratified by both parties:

• **A. General Provisions (Local) 1.d.** promote mutually respectful working relations between the Board and the Association and all employees.

• **B. Definitions (Local) 1.** The use of one gender in this Agreement shall include the others and the singular include the plural, unless the sense of the provisions provides otherwise.

• **F.20.2** The Board shall grant ninety-four thousand five hundred dollars (\$94,500) to the Association each year. Such payment shall be made *by September 1 annually*.
