
BENEFIT PLAN IMPROVEMENTS

The BCTF recently reached agreement with BCPSEA on further improvements to the provincial Extended Health Benefits (EHB) plan. If you recall, \$1.5-million of funding was allocated during provincial bargaining for improvements beginning on July 1, 2023, and a further \$2.0-million for improvements that will begin on July 1, 2024.
